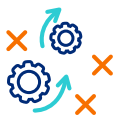
## Who is AnLar?

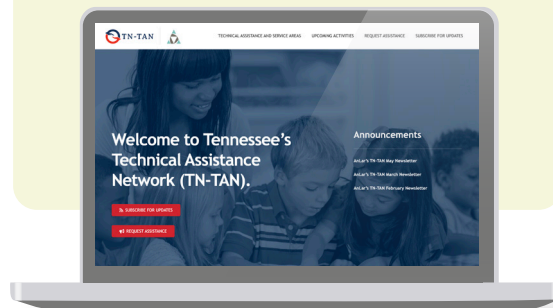
